COURSE CONTENT:

Classroom phase consists of 34 clock hours of instruction. After 6 hours, the student will take The State Road Rules and Signs Test. The student will receive an instruction permit after passing the tests. The instruction permit will cost an additional \$5.00 (not included in course fee) payable upon completion of test.
*Practice Driving phase consists of 7 clock hours of actual behind-the-wheel driving and 7 clock hours of in-car observation.

Upon satisfactorily completing both phases, the student receives a Certificate of Completion of the Driver Education Course.

Students who do not satisfactorily complete the entire course within one year will be required to surrender their instruction permit to the Department of Public Safety and retake the Driver Education Class.
