Summer School Dates:

Session I: June 8 – July 2 (M-TH), 8 -12

Location: New Braunfels Middle School

Registration:

Registration will begin May 11, 2009 in the NBMS Counseling office.

Out of District Students

- Students who reside outside the NBISD school district will be placed on a waiting list. Once all NBISD students are enrolled in classes, out of district students will be placed in available slots.

Registration Packet/Materials:

Students will be required to complete and return the following documents:

- Receipts of Summer School Student/Parent Handbook
- Middle School Application

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation is provided to the middle school summer programs. Parents must complete the transportation request form in order to receive summer transportation.

BREAKFAST/LUNCH:

Breakfast and lunch will be available for no charge to students. NBMS will be hosting the federal "Seamless Feeding Program" those in Comal County who are under 18 years of age. A hot breakfast and lunch will be provided each day of summer school. Breakfast will be served from 7:30 – 12:30. Lunch will be provided from 11:00 – 12:00.

ATTENDANCE:

- Students with more than 1 absence will be withdrawn from class and lose their credit. There are no refunds. There are no excused absences during summer school.
- Missing one day in summer school is equivalent to missing two weeks during the regular term.
- A maximum of 1 absence is permitted during each session of summer school.

TARDIES:

- Because of the short length of class sessions and academic intensity, prompt and consistent attendance is required.
- Students who are tardy (more than 10 minutes late) three times are subject to withdrawal from class without refund or credit. *Note:* 3 tardies = 1 absence.

DISCIPLINE MANAGEMENT:

- Students attending summer school with NBISD are held to the STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT.
- Infractions of the NBISD Student Code of Conduct may cause withdrawal from summer school without a refund.
 - Minor Infraction:
 - Student and Parents will be given two warnings by phone and/or in writing.
 - The third minor infraction will constitute removal from the summer school program.
 - Major Infraction:
 - Any major infraction, including, but not limited to, drugs, alcohol, weapons, and other to be determined by administration, will constitute an immediate removal from summer school and will be subject to disciplinary action determined by the NBISD Student Code of Conduct.

TUITION:

Tuition for 6-8 summer school is \$75.00. Students in 8th grade who are in the math or reading SSI summer program do not have to pay tuition for summer school.

Retention Policy for grades 1-8 (EIE Local)
